Accused-petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure challenging order dated 17.01.2019, passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya, declining the application under Section 311 Cr.P.C., for summoning the complainant Harpreet Kaur for further examination.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class has noticed that the complainant was examined and cross-examined on 09.11.2017, 30.11.2017 and 25.01.2018 and the receipt Ex.D1 is dated 28.08.2015. The learned trial Court has also noticed that the aforesaid fact was well within the knowledge of the accused and he had ample opportunity to put the said receipt to the complainant at the time of her cross-examination.

On 26.02.2019, the case was adjourned to enable the counsel to place on record the testimony of the complainant and reply to the legal notice. However, inspite of 3 opportunities given, documents as prayed for have not been filed.

The learned trial Court has given cogent reasons to dismiss the

application. Hence, this Court does not find any ground to interfere with the order passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya, in exercise of powers under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
