The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 358 dated 21.10.2017, under Sections 323, 380, 452, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is an unexplained delay of two days in lodging the FIR and the injuries, which were caused in the incident, are simple in nature. He further contends that vide order dated 25.02.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.
