Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.0013 dated 16.1.2019, under Section 307 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh on the basis of compromise dated 13.2.2019 (Annexure P-2).

As per the allegations contained in the FIR, head injury was caused to the complainant by a sharp edged weapon i.e. knife, which invited the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC.

Since the petition is founded on the basis of a compromise allegedly entered into between the parties and that to at a stage where the investigation is still pending, therefore, considering the nature of the offence no ground is made out for accepting the compromise to quash the

FIR in question.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
