In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

Heard.

Without commenting on the legality and validity of marriage between the petitioners, respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, is directed to look into the matter and do the needful, if required.

Petitioners are present in the Court. Petitioner No.2-Sahil Verma, is hereby directed to make necessary arrangement for fixed deposit of a sum of ₹3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs) in some nationalized bank in the name of petitioner No. 1-Indu, within a period of three months from today. The said FDR shall be for a period of 5 years.

Petitioner No. 2 is directed to deposit copy of the FDR in the Registry within a period of three months from today.

In case, he fails to do so, Registry is directed to list the matter on 31.05.2019.
