GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction for expeditious and fair investigation pertaining to FIR No. 77, dated 29.8.2018, registered at Police Station Banur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 307 and 326 IPC added later on).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that while accused Gurdeep Singh and Rupender Singh have been arrested but the main accused Gursewak Singh is still at large and who has been issuing threats to the petitioner and other members of his family.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali, to look into the matter and to dispose of the application dated

12.1.2019 (Annexure P-4) (although addressed to Director General of Police, Punjab) expeditiously. It be ensured that the effective steps be taken for securing presence of the remaining accused. In case any of the accused cannot be arrested then steps be taken for declaring such accused as a proclaimed offender so that the trial proceeds against the remaining co-accused.

A copy of this order along with copy of application Annexure P-4 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
