RAMENDRA JAIN, J.

Through this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No. 235 dated 5.12.2017, under Sections 406, 420, 120B IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, order dated 17.4.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the petitioner's deposit of alleged cheated amount before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate, which shall be converted into FDR in some nationalised bank so that the same may fetch maximum rate of interest to save loss of interest to the party who shall finally be entitled for it. In case the petitioner flouts this order, he shall be liable for contempt and the respondent/

complainant shall be at liberty to get revived this petition.

Order dated 6.12.2018 passed in CRM-M No. 28330 of 2018 by a Coordinate Bench of this Court shall form part of this order to throw light on the conduct of the petitioner.
