Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.102 dated 08.03.2018 registered under Sections 500, 504, 506 IPC and Section 67 of I.T Act, 2008 at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he made abusive comments against the son of the complainant on Facebook.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from Inspector Mahabir Singh has shown me the comments made by both the parties. In my opinion, there is very little to choose between them. They both have a flair for language and are able to express their thoughts in a very graphic manner.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, without

going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 08.03.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required. In case the petitioner does not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
