The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Raman in case FIR No.646 dated 18.07.2018, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366-A and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC"), at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

A bare perusal of the statement of the prosecutrix under Section 164 Cr.P.C. transpires that she had gone with petitioner-Deepak @ Deepu by her own. She has categorically stated that she wants to stay with Deepu.

In her absence, FIR was lodged by her father on the basis of suspicion to the effect that her daughter has been kidnapped by Deepak.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
