Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of petitioners at the instance of respondents No.5 to 7.

Admittedly, the petitioners are having love affair and they intend to marry each other. The petition is founded on the ground that they are facing threat at the hands of private respondents, who are opposing the love affair of the petitioners and the proposed marriage. It is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are carrying on with this love affair for the last seven years and during this period no untoward incident has ever happened. There is no particular manner or

mode of threat pleaded in the petition. It is also noticed that previously CRM-M-7234-2019 was filed by the petitioners, which already stood withdrawn by learned counsel for the petitioners on 15.2.2019.

The contents of the petition do not inspire confidence, resultantly, the petition is hereby dismissed.
