ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.111 dated 28.09.2018, under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners would not, *prima facie*, constitute an offence under Section 306/34 IPC. The FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant also states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 21.02.2019, had passed interim order in the same terms as in CRM-M-46134-2018 whereby the petitioner therein was directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-

interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Satnam Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 21.02.2019, granting interim bail in the same terms as in CRM-M-46134-2018 to the petitioners, is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
