Reply is filed. As per the said reply, SIT has been formed to go into the allegations.

In view of the above, contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, it goes without saying that SIT shall complete the investigation as early as possible and submit its report, as the case may be, within four months from today.
