This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.26 dated 06.11.2017, registered under Sections 22, 29, 61, 85 of NDPS Act at Police Station SSOC, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has been in custody for one year and two months (this fact is accepted by the learned Sr. DAG). He further stated that recovery was 270 gms of heroine which is marginally more than commercial quantity and antecedents of the petitioner are clean. Learned Senior DAG on instructions from SI Vishal Rajput has accepted this assertion.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into

the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
