This order shall dispose off a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of Complaint No. 2801/2016 dated 05.02.2014 titled as **Baljit Kaur** Vs. **Gurjit Singh** under Sections 406/498-A/323 IPC, Police Station Chattiwind, Amritsar pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, on the basis of compromise.

Report dated 20.09.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received whereby after recording statements

of respondent/complainant Baljit Kaur and accused/petitioners-Ranjit Singh, Gurjeet Singh and Balbir Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure

Moreover, the private parties to this petition have put in appearance before this Court and during the course of interaction with the parties, it transpired that they have compromised the matter and resolved to end the dispute.

Heard.

In the light of joint statement made by the parties and together with the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed. Complaint No. 2801/2016 dated 05.02.2014 titled as **Baljit Kaur Vs. Gurjit Singh** under Sections 406/498-A/323 IPC, Police Station Chattiwind, Amritsar pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar and all other consequences arising out of the said complaint qua the

petitioners is quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
