Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.42 dated 17.02.2018 under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Section 13 of Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 22.03.2018, arrest of the petitioner was stayed. Thereafter, the petitioner joined the investigation and the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of some settlement between the parties.

The Mediator has submitted a settlement/agreement arrived at between the parties and as per Clause 6 of the settlement/agreement, the parties have settled their dispute and the petitioner has undertaken to pay an amount of

Rs.3.00 lacs at the time of filing a petition praying for quashing of FIR, on the basis of compromise and remaining amount of Rs.3.00 lacs will be paid at the time of quashing of the FIR by this Court.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid order dated 22.03.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions as agreed before the Mediator.

Liberty is granted to the complainant to revive this petition, in case the petitioner failed to comply with the terms and conditions of the settlement/agreement.
