AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 21.01.2010 passed by this Court in CWP No.20383 of 2009.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Sukhjeet Pal Singh, Director of Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab annexing order dated 02.11.2010 has been filed today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State submits that claim of the petitioner was rejected and order communicated to the petitioner.

In view of order passed, learned counsel for the petitioner
