AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 21.01.2010 passed by this Court in CWP No.20379 of 2009.

Learned State counsel has produced order dated 09.04.2012 whereby claim of the petitioner has been rejected. It is submitted that said order was also sent to the petitioner.

In view of order passed, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
