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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner Pala Ram has been convicted in FIR No. 2 dated 1.4.2009 under Sections 302/34 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Karnal and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment.

Earlier the petitioner was allowed parole vide order dated 27.06.2018 for a period of four weeks for agricultural purposes. He was to surrender on 04.01.2019. During the parole period, he suffered heart attack and was referred to PGI, Chandigarh on 30.12.2018. The petitioner was admitted in PGI on 31.12.2018. He filed CWP No. 1741 of 2019 seeking emergency parole for his treatment. He was granted emergency parole and is due to surrender on 22.02.2019. The petitioner has been regularly visiting PGI, Chandigarh during this period. Now he has been advised to undergo bypass surgery. He was admitted for treatment at PGI Chandigarh on 14.02.2019 and is presently undergoing tests for bypass surgery, which may take place within one week. The petitioner has submitted representation dated 14.02.2019 seeking extension of parole. Alongwith the application he had enclosed his medical record. However, respondents have not taken any decision on his application.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Neeraj Poswal, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice. In view of the urgency of the situation, a formal reply is not being called for.

In view of the averments in the petition and the enclosed medical record, this petition is allowed. The parole of the petitioner is extended by further period of six weeks commencing from 22.2.2019. He shall surrender before the Jail Authorities concerned after the expiry of said period.
