The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.82 dated 22.04.2017 registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drug and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'the NDPS Act') at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

The operative part of the order dated 22.02.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail and was facing the trial regularly. It is further submitted that on account of noting a wrong date i.e. 18.01.2019 instead of 18.12.2018, he absented the Court proceedings on 18.12.2018, therefore, the trial Court has forfeited his bail/surety bonds and non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner is

ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for fresh bail.

Notice of motion for 04.04.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 22.02.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has deposited the costs of Rs.5,000/-.

Counsel for the petitioner has also placed on record the order dated 27.02.2019 as well as the receipt dated 27.02.2019 as Mark 'T'.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Azad Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
