Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to decide the representation dated 05.12.2018 for taking the action against respondents No.4 to 8.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Nawanshahr, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. As per this reply, on receiving a complaint from the petitioner, with the allegation that respondents No.4 to 8 have caused injury to him on 01.12.2018, by taking him to an undisclosed place and have conducted certain photography, which was duly inquired into. It is further stated that during the inquiry, it was found that there is a dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.4 regarding payment of certain amounts and later on, there was a compromise between them and on

one occasion, the petitioner has even apologized for not making the payment to the private respondent(s). It is also stated in the affidavit that MLR of the petitioner was also found misleading, as the injury was found to be self-inflicting. A detailed inquiry report is attached with this affidavit as Annexure R-1, in which it is concluded that the petitioner has made up a story on account of financial dispute and accordingly, representation of the petitioner was filed.

In view of the above, no further action is called for, in the present petition and the same is disposed of.
