The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of the impugned order dated 20.02.2018 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, in CRA-253-2017 arising out of the complaint case No. 3259 of 2015 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the mediation proceedings have failed and the compromise between the parties could not be affected and the appeal against the conviction order dated 01.05.2017, is pending before the learned Appellate Court.

These facts have not been disputed by the learned counsel for the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-Ram Lubhaya further stated that he has paid a Demand Draft of ₹3 lacs to the respondent, which has been encashed.

In view of the above, the matter is relegated to the learned Appellate Court for the remaining grievances. As far as the interest part is concerned, the Appellate Court will hear the petitioner-Ram Lubhaya as per law.
