The petitioners allege that they are being unnecessarily harassed by respondent No.3 on account of a complaint having been submitted by respondent No.4. The petitioners are being pressurized to pay money to respondent No.4 or else they would be implicated in a false criminal case. A detailed representation dated 19.2.2019 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted to respondent No.2 but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, learned AAG, Punjab accepts notice. Let three copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

No reply is necessary to be filed considering the nature of order being passed.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 19.2.2019 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
