Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C, is for the issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondent Nos.4 and 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age, petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of her Adhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 24.8.1999. Petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of his Adhar Card (Annexure P-2) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 20.2.1990. They have also moved a representation before the SSP Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.2) to take an appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
