The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 18.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 22827 of 2018. The operational part of the order is quoted below:

“Result has been produced in the Court. The petitioner has secured 86+11 marks in the SC category. Last Candidate has got secured 94 marks. Petitioner will take all the originals documents along with B.Ed marks sheets.

Petitioner is entitled for all consequential benefits except salary.

The present petition stands allowed.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the appointment letter has been issued to the petitioner but the consequential benefits except salary have not been released.

Learned State counsel submits that needful will be done expeditiously even though there was no time bound directions given by this

Court with regard to the consequential benefits.

Since the appointment letter has already been issued to the petitioner, there is no doubt that the needful consequential benefits would be released with reasonable time.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the contempt petition stands disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against respondents is discharged.
