GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (ORAL)

Present writ petition has been filed by petitioner-Anu, *inter alia*, with a prayer to direct the respondents No. 1 and 2 to declare the result of 4th year BDS course (final year) of Roll No. 410566.

It is contended that the petitioner appeared in the 4th year BDS course in compliance of order dated 17.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division) Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a detailed judgment/order has been given by the Civil Court. Vide judgment dated 17.07.2018, the Civil Court had passed an order directing that the defendants therein were directed to re-evaluate the answer sheets of the plaintiff from any two senior professor/expert of Government Dental Colleges except the staff of PGIMS, Rohtak. It was further directed that

until the papers will be re-evaluated, if the examination of 4th year BDS course starts, then the defendants are directed to allow the plaintiff to attend the examination of 4th year of BDS course, subject to the final outcome of the result of re-evaluation.

It is submitted that thereafter the petitioner appeared in the 4th year examination. The appeal was filed against this order, which was dismissed vide order dated 06.10.2018/31.10.2018. Copy of which is appended herewith as Annexure P-3.

The parties before this Court do not dispute the factual position.

In view of the above, since main suit was also rendered infructuous in view of the fact that the petitioner had already undertaken the 4th year exam, in the present writ petition also no further directions are called for except that respondents are directed to declare the result of the 4th year examination within two weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

It is further directed that all the consequential benefits of the declaration that is further permission to pursue her apprenticeship shall also be permitted by the respondents in accordance with law.

Writ petition, is accordingly disposed of.
