Learned counsel for the petitioner has made statement that as per instructions received, the petitioner-Sushil Kumar @ Vicky does not objects if the complainant/respondent No.2 withdraws the amount detailed in order dated 29.04.2019 passed by this Court.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nanak Singh, Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur, submits that petitioner in consequence of order dated 22.02.2019 has joined the

investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and does not oppose the grant of bail.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.02.2019 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
