The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the complaint No.160 dated 03.02.2012/13.01.2014 under Section 138 read with Section 141 and 142 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 as well as the summoning order dated 11.02.2012.

During the course of hearing, it has been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner that the entire prosecution evidence in the case is over before learned trial Court.
