Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.12 dated 20.01.2019, under Sections 452, 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 22.02.2019 :-

“Contends that except Section 452 IPC, the other offences are bailable and moreover, there is a delay of two days in lodging of the FIR.

Notice of motion for 25.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

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Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Pinjor Singh has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 22.02.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
