Petitioner Nanak Chand has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.27 dated 09.4.2014, under Section 304-A IPC (later on Sections 279 and 427 IPC added), registered at Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridkot (Annexure P-1) as well as for setting aside the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 16.11.2018 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridkot, on the basis of compromise dated 29.1.2019 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners prays that the compromise effected between the parties can be useful for reduction of sentence.

This plea, raised by learned counsel for the petitioner cannot be entertained as the appeal before the first Appellate Court is pending.

In view of the above as well as the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in State of Punjab vs. Saurabh Bakshi 2015(2) RCR (Criminal) 495, no ground is made out for quashing of the FIR in question.

The petition stands dismissed.
