Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0026 dated 02.02.2019, under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Division No.7, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

This Court passed the following order on 25.02.2019:-

“Contentends that this Court, vide order dated 25.02.2019 (P-8) passed in CRM-M-8000-2019, has already granted ad-interim protection to co-accused of the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 28.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of her arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit her to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on her furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

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To be heard along with CRM-M-8000-2019.”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Resham Singh has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 25.02.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
