Petitioners seek a Mandamus for directing the respondent-Pepsu Road Transport Corporation to release to them overtime allowance.

Petitioner no.1 is stated to have been engaged initially on the post of Conductor and thereafter adjusted as a Driver.

Petitioner no.2 has served on the post of Driver and has since superannuated.

Even though, the claim in the instant petition is for release of overtime allowance, yet, the instant petition is completely bereft of the necessary details as regards duty hours of the petitioners and the particulars of the timings/dates on which they had performed their duties and responsibilities beyond the prescribed duty hours so as to raise a claim for overtime allowance.

In the absence of the necessary averments and pleadings, prayer made in the instant petition cannot be examined and adjudicated upon.

Writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, it will be open for the petitioner to reagitate the issue by filing a petition afresh but with better particulars.
