Petitioner No.2 is hereby directed to make necessary arrangement for fixed deposit of a sum of ₹3.00 lacs in some nationalized bank in the name of petitioner No.1- Bavita Sharma within a period of two months from today. The said FDR shall be for a period of 5 years. Petitioner No.2 is directed to deposit copy of the FDR in the Registry within a period of two months from today. In case, he fails to do so, Registry is directed to list the matter on 08.05.2019.
