The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.58 dated 25.01.2019, under Sections 324 and 307 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, and Section 25,54,59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Jind City, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner, who is a national level wrestler. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case. He also contends that as per the order dated 27.02.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ram Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and knife has been recovered from him but he is required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner has joined investigation, interim order dated 27.02.2019 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
