RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

Minor-Baby Rani @ Mandeep Kaur through her father has laid challenge to the award dated 27.07.1993 of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Karnal (for short, 'the Tribunal) awarding her compensation of Rs.5,000/- towards medical treatment on account of injury sustained by her in a motor vehicular accident occurred on 09.12.1989 due to rash and negligent driving of truck bearing registration No.PCS-9881.

Heard.

Having given thoughtful consideration to the rival submissions, this Court is not inclined to enhance the amount, already awarded by the learned Tribunal to the appellant, considering her hospitalisation only for two days in dressing and suturing of her wound. The accident took place in the year 1989. The impugned award was passed in the year 1993. Rs.5,000/- awarded to the appellant in the year 1993 along with interest is an handsome amount against the medical bills of Rs.1725/- only.

I have gone through the impugned award and find no scope of modifying the same.

Dismissed.
