1. Challenge in this petition is to an order refusing request for withdrawing resignation letter after its acceptance.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper-book.

3. No ground for interference is made out after the resignation voluntarily submitted on 3.1.2019 accepted by the District & Sessions Judge, Sirsa on 19.1.2019. Request made on 21.1.2019 for permission to withdraw the resignation is not tenable. The petitioner had on his free will resigned while working as a probationary Clerk in the Sessions Division, Sirsa on securing appointment as a Restorer in the establishment of the Delhi High Court where he has joined service on 23.1.2019.

4. The petitioner makes a story that he is the only son of his aged parents and under their pressure, he moved the application withdrawing resignation for family reasons, but the same has been wrongly rejected vide

order dated 23.1.2019 when it could easily have been allowed for him to join

back to look after his parents. He says his father has medical problems and he is the only son. It is this order which has been challenged in this petition. No interference is called for in this case merely on the ground of compassion and sympathy. As a result, I find no merit in this petition which fails and is dismissed.
