ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.346 dated 11.07.2018, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Daruhera, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that allegations against the petitioners are that while obtaining loan of ₹2 lacs under the Kisan Credit Scheme, the petitioners had mortgaged their share of the land which was found to be much less than the share they had projected.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 22.02.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhagwan Dass, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 22.02.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
