The instant writ petition is directed against the order dated 9.2.2019, Annexure P.22, passed by the District Magistrate, Jhajjar and in terms of which an application moved by the petitioner for grant of arms licence has been filed.

A complete copy of the writ petition was handed over to learned State counsel.

The matter was taken up during resumed hearing in the post-lunch sessions.

Learned State counsel has clarified that the impugned order dated 9.2.2019 would be construed as an order declining the application of the petitioner for grant of arms licence. Further State counsel submits that the petitioner would have a statutory remedy of appeal against

the order passed by the District Magistrate, Jhajjar before the Divisional Commissioner concerned.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to avail of his statutory remedy before the Appellate Authority.

It is clarified that this Court has not examined the validity of the order declining the arms licence on merits.
