The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.2 dated 8.1.2019 (Annexure P/1), under Sections 195-A, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City II, Abohar, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner in the FIR is that he is alleged to have threatened the complainant who was a witness in another case.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 11.3.2019 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balwinder Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the

petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 14.2.2019 granting bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
