Instant petition has been filed seeking a Mandamus directing the respondents not to terminate the services of the petitioners till regular appointees are engaged.

Pleadings on record would indicate that petitioner no.1 was engaged as a Lab. Technician and petitioner no.2 on the post of Librarian purely on contractual basis in the year 2011. Such contractual engagement was for a period of 11 months and which was subsequently extended. It is the pleaded case of the petitioners themselves that the last extension was granted for a period of three months i.e. we.f. 21.1.2017 to 20.4.2017.

Counsel concedes that the petitioners have been out of job for the last two years.

It is not the case made out on behalf of the petitioners that they have been replaced by the respondent-Shivalik College of Pharmacy, Nangal by another similar contractual arrangement.

Faced with a situation where this Court was not inclined to intervene in the matter, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
