AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The petitioners filed a writ petition in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the action of the respondent of replacing the petitioner by fresh contractual employees and for direction that petitioners shall continue till regular selection is made. The writ petition was allowed on 10.09.2018. It was ordered that petitioners would continue to work on their posts till regular selection is made and they would be entitled to salary as per minimum pay scale from the date of appointment as admissible to regular employees. However, dispute raised in the contempt petition is that in spite of the fact that petitioners are continuing on the post and are being paid salary but the same is not as per minimum pay scale.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to show that the said grievance was ever raised before the respondents that salary being received by them is not as per directions dated 10.09.2018 of this Court.

The contempt petition is disposed of at this stage. Let the petitioners approach the respondents, through representation, to raise grievance with regard to salary not being paid as per minimum pay scale admissible to regular employees. In case needful is done, representation would be decided by the respondents expeditiously by passing a reasoned order after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners. The needful shall be done within four weeks from receipt of representation.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
