INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.108 dated 11.12.2018, registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 307, 325, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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Perusal of record shows that the present petitioner is named in the FIR and he was holding a cloth. It is specifically mentioned in the FIR that the present petitioner with an intention to kill the complainant put his *parna* around the neck of the complainant and threw the complainant down on the road. Thereafter, other accused caused injuries on the face of the complainant.

Learned State counsel has shown photographs of the injured to this Court and there are clear visible marks on the neck of injured and face of injured is swollen one in the photographs.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of the serious allegations levelled against the present petitioner and in view of the active role played by him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
