By this petition the petitioner is seeking direction to the Special Judge, Jalandhar to expedite the trial in case FIR No.313 dated 02.12.2017 registered under Section 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the challan was presented more than a year ago and there are total 14 witnesses out of which only 2 have been examined till date. Further he states that this is a case of small recovery of intoxicating tablets under the NDPS Act.

Learned Senior Deputy Advocate General has very fairly accepted this fact and has stated that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 10.06.2019 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

In view of the statement of the learned State Counsel, the petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
