On 25.2.2019, following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel contends that the petitioners have been summoned with the aid of Section 319 Cr.P.C mainly on the basis of statement of PW Balwinder Singh @ Sandy. The learned counsel has submitted that infact the statement of Balwinder Singh @ Sandy had also been recorded in terms of Section 164 Cr.P.C, wherein he has not stated a word against petitioner No.2 Amarjit Kaur, wife of Jaswinder Singh @ Bunty, and the only role attributed to the petitioner No.1 as per the said statement, is that he had pushed Balwinder Singh @ Sandy and gave a slap while it is Amrik Singh @ Mika, who is alleged to have poured acid upon him.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their

furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

The petitioners had filed present petition for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.228, dated 30.8.2016 registered under Section 326-A IPC at Police Station Saultanwind, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harwinder Singh has submitted that both the petitioners have not come forward to join the investigation as directed. Both the petitioners have not appeared before the trial Court also, although they have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Allegations as per the case of the prosecution were that injured had suffered acid attack at the hands of the accused and hence, the petition is dismissed.
