Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.157 dated 26.10.2016 registered under Sections 120B, 506 of IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act at Women Police Station, Faridabad.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kallu Singh, states that despite there being an order granting interim bail to the petitioner, she has not joined the investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner states that he has no instructions in the case as despite efforts made by him, the petitioner could not be contacted.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has not joined the investigation and moreover, she has been declared PO, for which, she has filed a separate petition i.e. **CRM-M-8778-2019** seeking quashing of PO order, the present petition is dismissed in default for non-joining the investigation, as directed.
