In the present writ petition, the prayer made by the petitioner is that the salary of the petitioner for the month of September and October, 1996 is still due and was not paid to the petitioner despite the fact that the petitioner has already retired from service.

No justifiable reason has been presented to the Court as to why the petitioner is approaching after approximately more than 20 years for claiming the salary for those months and the same was not done when the petitioner was in service.

Be that as it may, the petitioner has filed a representation dated 18.08.2015 (Annexure P-2) to the respondents claiming the said benefit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 18.08.2015 (Annexure P-2) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 18.08.2015 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 18.08.2015 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
