Petitioner Harpreet Kaur has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.204 dated 19.07.2017, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323, 324, 326 (added later on), 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. She is stated to have given simple injury on the head of the complainant with thapi.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 25.02.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not

required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from her. No useful purpose would be served by sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 25.02.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
