By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to official respondents so as to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.7 to 13.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that members of the family of the petitioners had filed a civil suit against respondent No.7 seeking specific performance of agreement dated 23.6.2017 for sale of property, executed by respondent No.7. It has been submitted that after filing of the said civil suit, respondents No.7 to 13 have been pressurizing the petitioners to compromise the matter and have been issuing threats of dire consequences in case they do not withdraw the suit.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Commissioner of

Police, District Jalandhar to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-3), made by petitioners, expeditiously, in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law at the earliest. Further, in case the petitioners are required to be associated in connection with any inquiry or any information is to be elicited from them, then a prior written notice be furnished to them.

A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.4-Commissioner of Police, District Jalandhar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
