Present petition has been filed for quashing of criminal complaint and summoning order issued under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act.

It has been claimed that the petitioner has no connection with accused no.1 i.e. M/s Kay Tech Business Corporation , which is a proprietor business corporation of his father, Kapil Mehra.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute this position. He also admits that the petitioner is not signatory to the cheque and he has no objection if petitioner-accused no.2 is deleted from the array of the accused. Hence, the complaint qua petitioner-accused no.2 may be dismissed as withdrawn.
