The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.337, dated 4.12.2018, registered under Section 18/22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Phillaur, Jalandhar.

As per allegations, 15 injections of Bupronorphine and 50 grams of opium as well as 300 intoxicating tablets were recovered.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that all the recovered contraband are of small quantity and the petitioner has now been in custody for more than two and half months of custody.

Learned DAG Punjab has filed the custody certificate, as per which the petitioner has undergone 2 months and 22 days of custody. She, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Kumar, has accepted the factual

assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
