HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at the time of retirement, the basic pay of the petitioner was Rs.79,000/- but while fixing the pension, the same was taken to Rs.77,000/- due to which the petitioner is getting less pension every month.

In respect of the grievance raised by the petitioner, he has served upon the respondents with a legal notice dated 29.09.2018 (Annexure P-6). Counsel for the petitioner states that the said legal notice is still under consideration which is clear from the letter Annexure P-7 dated 01.11.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no final order has been passed by the respondents deciding the said legal notice (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 29.09.2018 (Annexure P-6) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the legal notice dated 29.09.2018 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 29.09.2018 (Annexure P-6) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
