FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, submits that petitioner in consequence of order dated 03.04.2018 has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and does not oppose the grant of bail.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed the grant of bail on the ground that gold ornaments are yet to be recovered.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 03.04.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
